Abdul Fattah Retains As Angkasa President

KUALA LUMPUR, July 22 (Bernama) -- Datuk Abdul Fattah Abdullah today retained his post as President of the National Cooperatives Movement of Malaysia (Angkasa) in an election at the 32nd Angkasa Annual National Conference today.

Angkasa said in a statement that Abdul Fattah obtained 3,083 votes, defeating his challenger Dr Arriffin Mansor who obtained 569 votes.

The results were announced by conference chairman, associate professor Dr Abdul Rahman Abdul Razak Shaik at the Putra World Trade Centre here.

The post of deputy president was won uncontested by Mutadho Bahri.

Meanwhile, Mohamad Azmi Omaruddin retained his post of vice-president after gaining 2,250 votes.

Also elected as vice-president was the chairman of Angkasa's internal audit committee, Mohd Azlan Yahya, who obtained 1,712 undi.

The two beat four other candidates - Datin Seri Dr Jamilah Din who obtained 987 votes, Dr Mustapa Kamal Maulut (859), Yunus Kasim (756) and Dr Razmi Ab Rahman (240).

A total of 4,016 representatives of 3,694 cooperative members of Angkasa from throughout the country attended the conference.
