Angkasa signs agreement with RAMCI and CTOS

KUALA LUMPUR: The National Cooperatives Movement of Malaysia (Angkasa) today signed an agreement with RAM Credit Information Sdn Bhd (RAMCI) and Credit Tip Off Services Sdn Bhd (CTOS).

The agreement is to provide data on salary deduction for Angkasa bureaus owned by Angkasa through the Angkasa Credit Report System and RAMCI's which is known as SPeKAR to CTOS.

Angkasa president, Datuk Abdul Fattah Abdullah said SPeKAR is a individual credit information search system which combines the data for salary deductions managed by Angkasa while valued credit information is managed by RAMCI.

"SPeKAR is also the only complete credit search system in Malaysia," he said, adding that SPeKAR which is now in its fifth year, has almost 200 customer organisations comprising cooperatives and non-cooperatives.

He said the agreement for collaboration would enable the information on deductions for Angkasa bureaus to be accessed not only through the SPeKAR and RAMCI systems, but also by CTOS customers.

"I hope this collaboration between SPeKAR and CTOS will lead to agreements with other credit report agencies like the Credit Bureau Malaysia Sdn Bhd (CBM) and FIS Data Reference Sdn Bhd," he said. -- Bernama
